Bangladesh Details: Bangladesh, to the east of India on the Bay of Bengal, is a South Asian country marked by lush greenery and many waterways. Its Padma (Ganges), Meghna and Jamuna rivers create fertile plains, and travel by boat is common. On the southern coast, the Sundarbans, an enormous mangrove forest shared with Eastern India, is home to the royal Bengal tiger.

Currency: Bangladeshi taka.

Bangladesh Currency: 1 Bangladeshi Taka equals = 0.86 Indian Rupee.

Language of Bangladesh: Languages of Bangladesh. Bengali (Bangla), the national language of Bangladesh, belongs to the Indo-Aryan group of languages and is related to Sanskrit. Like Pali, however, and various other forms of Prakrit in ancient India, Bengali originated beyond the influence of the Brahman society of the Aryans.

Time Difference India & Bangladesh: Bangladesh is 30 minutes ahead of India.

Temperature **Bangladesh**: In the long-term, the Bangladesh Average Temperature is projected to trend **around 25.42 celsius** in 2021, according to our econometric models. Bangladesh has a humid, warm climate influenced by pre-monsoon, monsoon and post-monsoon circulations and frequently experiences heavy precipitation and tropical cyclones. Bangladesh's historical climate has experienced average temperatures around 26°C, but **range between 15°C and 34°C throughout the year**.

Admission for International Students:

Letter of Invitation: For Admission to the University and issue of visa for travel to Bangladesh, the student will first send their high school mark sheet and a copy of the passport with name, passport number and date of birth of student.

On this basis a "Letter of Invitation" will be issued. This is a legal document on the basis of which a student can apply for a visa from the Embassy of Bangladesh. A payment is to be made for the letter of invitation.

Documents for Visa: Other Documents needed for the Visa are:

- 1. Copy of the Document of Education with the list of studied courses (subjects) and received grades (points or marks) in original
- 2. A copy of the Certificate of Birth in original
- 3. Health Certificate by an authorized clinic issued not more than two month before the date of entry to Bangladesh.
- 4. Document showing the absence of HIV infection, unless otherwise provided by international agreements of Bangladesh.
- 5. Insurance policy for emergency medical care (except for foreigners having arrived from countries with which agreements on free provision of emergency medical care concluded)
- 6. 12 Passport sized photos

Issue of Visa by Embassy: Documents are to be certified, legalized and translated to Bangladesh before submission to the Embassy of Bangladesh covering the student's home country. The Embassy may hold a personal interview of the student to establish credentials; before issue of visa. Student Visas are issued from Mid-August till mid-November.

Arrival in Bangladesh:

Last date of application is subject to verification. Please consult with your consultant to know the requisite details.

Academic Plan for MBBS at Bikrampur Bhuiyan Medical College:

The main course offered is the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery MBBS for 5 years of study. The college follows the curriculum approved by the Dhaka University and Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council. The courses within are divided into the following subtopics:

Clinical subjects-Medicine including Psychiatry and Dermatology, Surgery including Ophthalmology and Otolaryngology and Genecology and Obstetrics The college has admitted 24 batches of students since its inception. 19 batches of students have completed their MBBS course.


