For Full Acceptance

- Complete the Application form.
- Official transcripts of previous education
- Two letters of recommendation – One academic and One Social
- Criminal background check or Local Police Record
- Personal Statement – A short essay addressing why you want to become a doctor (500 words or less)
- Current curriculum vitae
- A valid passport (a copy of bio page to be submitted)

- Medical School licensed by Government of Antigua and Barbuda
- Medical School is approved by WHO
- Medical School is listed in WDOMS
- MD program approved by Antigua and Barbuda National Accreditation Board
- Curriculum mapped to global licensure requirements like USA, UK, India, Pakistan, Nigeria, etc.
- Choice of Clinical training in USA, UK, Nepal, and Caribbean
- USCE as part of MD program → vital for securing US residency (postgraduation) position → US residency positions are paid positions obtained after completing our MD degree

Program Offered

Premedical Program

- Fulfills the prerequisites needed to join MD program
- Awards 90 credits
- Advanced standing/placement possible for previously earned college credits, bachelor's in science, pharmacy, or possessing a nursing degree. Contact Admissions office to enquire regarding exemptions.

Basic Science or Preclinical Program

- 75-week Program that is divided into 5 semesters
- Conducted in Antigua
- Transfer credits from other regionally approved medical school accepted

Clinical Science program

- 72-week program divided into 6 semesters
- Comprises of 48 weeks of Core Clerkships and 24 weeks of Elective Clerkships
- It can be done in USA, UK, Nepal and Antigua
- Transfer credits from other regionally approved medical school accepted

Financial Aid

Merit-based Scholarships
Based on GPA
Allows up to 40% reduction in premedical and basic science tuition

Need-based Scholarships
For students facing sudden economic hardships
Allows up to 40% reduction in premedical and basic science tuition

Antigua Scholarships
For all Antigua citizens
50% reduction in premedical and basic science tuition

CARICOM Scholarships
For all CARICOM citizens
Allows up to 40% reduction in premedical and basic science tuition
